| Level 1             | TotalCheck Screening Package – 1 name/location search for misdemeanors within 1 year, felonies within 7 years (annual screen)   |
| Level 1+            | TotalCheck Screening Package – 1 name/location search for misdemeanors within 1 year, felonies within 7 years + 10-panel drug test (annual screen & drug test)  |
| Level 2             | TotalCheck Plus Screening Package – All name/location combinations search for misdemeanors within 5 years, felonies within 7 years (annual screen)  |
| Level 2+            | TotalCheck Plus Screening Package – All name/location combinations search for misdemeanors within 5 years, felonies within 7 years + 10-panel drug test (annual screen & drug test)   |
| Level 3             | TotalCheck Plus Screening Package – All name/location combinations search for misdemeanors within 5 years, felonies within 7 years to include continuous criminal monitoring, medical exclusions, and digital badges (annual screen)                                  |
| Level 3+            | TotalCheck Plus Screening Package – All name/location combinations search for misdemeanors within 5 years, felonies within 7 years to include continuous criminal monitoring, medical exclusions, and digital badges + 10-panel drug test (annual screen & drug test) |
